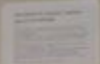

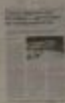

Stop The Violence!

There are at least 20 cases annually in which women are murdered by their husband
Every 3th woman in a family is abused and 1/3 are killed but wife is not
highly

2% of women have experienced domestic violence in their life

18: 1000 women turned to center for assistance
women of 3 suffered
1 man died for domestic violence
100 children have witnessed episodes of
rage of violence

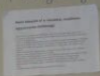
On average, 1 woman is killed every 10 days for domestic violence in the Czech Republic. There are 400 cases each

- SUFFERED FROM VIOLENCE AND TRAUMA
- ADDICTION (ALCOHOL, DRUGS)
- IT'S A FEMALE RELATIONSHIP (UNEMPLOYED, UNEMPLOYED)
- WANTING TO FEEL SUPERIOR

SUGGESTIONS

- TELL A FRIEND, TEACHER, PSYCHOLOGIST, INSTITUTION (SCHOOL), PARENTS
- TALK TO AUTHORITIES AT THE MOMENT, DO NOT EXPECT IT TO HAPPEN AGAIN

FINAL CODE

Any person that has used force against another person, or who has threatened to do so, or who has caused physical injury to another person, or who has caused psychological damage to another person, or who has caused financial damage to another person, or who has caused any other damage to another person, shall be liable to a fine of up to 100,000 pesetas, or to imprisonment for up to 6 months, or to both, at the discretion of the court.

Common consequences

- Psychological problems
- Trust issues
- Fear the abuse will recur
- Become aggressive
- Depression
- Suicide or homicide

Background
 Domestic violence is a pattern of behavior that includes physical, sexual, emotional, and economic abuse. It is often a cycle of violence, with periods of calm and periods of intense abuse.

Signs
 Signs of domestic violence include: frequent arguments, jealousy, controlling behavior, isolation from friends and family, and physical injuries.

Causes
 Causes of domestic violence include: childhood trauma, mental health issues, substance abuse, and social norms that condone violence against women.

Types
 Types of domestic violence include: physical, sexual, emotional, and economic abuse.

Statistics
 Statistics show that domestic violence is a global problem, affecting women of all ages and ethnicities. In the United States, approximately 1 in 4 women has experienced physical or sexual violence by an intimate partner.

→ Characteristics of people who are violent: They are often young, have low self-esteem, and are often unemployed. They may have a history of violence against others.

→ 200-24000 complaints
 - 200 arrests

→ A man beat his wife with a knife
 → A man was killed with a knife

→ A man who threatened to kill his wife for having an affair, was sentenced to 10 years in prison and 100,000 pesetas fine.

 AT LEAST 3 MILLION WOMEN OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE
 25% OF WOMEN HAVE EXPERIENCED DOMESTIC VIOLENCE
 22% OF VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN IS AGAINST WOMEN

 → 6 months - 1 year in prison
 → 2-3 years in prison
 → 5-10 years in prison

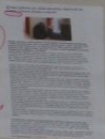

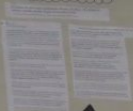

Punishment:

- 6 months - 4 years: abuse of a person living in a common dwelling
- 1-4 years: 1. rape, harboring intent of a rape
2. causing serious physical injury
3. committing to at least 2 persons
4. longevity
- 5-10 years: 1. rape, causing injury to at least 2 persons
2. death

CONSEQUENCES OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

- UNTIL 6 MONTHS OF IMPRISONMENT WITH A FINE FOR BEATING
- UNTIL 4 YEARS OF IMPRISONMENT FOR PRIVATE VIOLENCE
- WITH A CHARGE FOR THREAT AND IF IT'S A SERIOUS THREAT IT CAN BE PROSECUTED
- WITH A CHARGE FOR STALKING

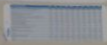

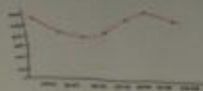

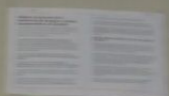
