1. What can you share with us about the idea and where it came from?

Of course many people contributed to the show over the years, but it was mainly my idea. Our viewers are obsessed by the real lives of celebrities and sports heroes already. Reality television is everywhere. We were brave enough to take the next logical step.

1. Some have criticized you, saying you have a god-complex. How would you answer these detractors?

A god complex? I haven't heard that before. I suppose its not incorrect. I arranged Truman's whole life. I gave him his education, his food, his friends—his whole world! I think I was far more kind than God, of course, who sent his son to be crucified—my Truman lived a perfect life!

1. Some have said that the name "Truman" is a homonym for "true man" Is that where the name came from? What truth did you show during this show?

Naturally, that is where the name came from. The Truman Show was the TRUE life story of a man. Reality television and professional wrestling claim to tell true stories, but we all know they are scripted. We at the studio were the only ones in the entertainment industry to arrange for the truth to be shown to viewers. Truman was the only person in the show whose reactions were true. Although he lived in a fake world, his emotions were real.
