
# MANIPULATIVE MEDIA

 via mass communication.


#### Social media

- These people not only influence our opinion, but our lifestyle as well.









#### PROs & CONs

- Helps us stay informed this can be both good and bad because, as we said, they tell us what they want us to know.




- Many cartoons and movies try to fight drugs, alcohol..but some of them even encourage their use.
- We can easily be influeced by music, and most artists, may not be aware, but are in one way or another supporting various drugs, especially in Hip-Hop culture.






- Media can be used in a bad way, to make us believe in something that may not be true.
- We become "sheep in a herd", without our own personal opinion.


