- So first of all: Truman I think the main question is What was your first thing to do when you escaped from the studio?
- -I wasn't believing in my eyes. Real life looked like the studio's nature, but it was a whole new feeling, that im free now.
- Then, we can say, you are happier now. What do you think, Which signs made you really suspicious?
- -I wasn't suspicious, but some things attracted my attention. For example when a stage light fell off from the air or when I saw my father walking on the streets.
- Yeah, Ok so let me see, Sylvia, How did you feel when you found out that he was planning to escape?

After I was kicked out I continued to watch the show at home but I felt miserable and was sorry for him as I watched him living his own life totally blind to the fact that it's all fake. When he started to doubt everything and remembered what I said to him on the beach that day i was hoping that he would find out the truth. I was thrilled and relieved when I saw that he had escaped and I felt like I had a small part in it.

- Buti f you were in the show why did you try to reveal him the truth?

Because it is a totally different experience to watch the show from the comfort of your own house compared to the feeling of being on a set where the main character doesn't even know that it is actually a show. It was very strange at first and it opened my eyes about the fact that he has no choice over his own life. He was kept in a bubble all along, he was imprisoned and i find it extremly cruel. That's why I decided to expose him to the truth. He had the right to know that he was kept in a synthetic environment, his life was staged, his relatives and friends were fake and his reality was not genuine. Unfortunatelly he did not believe me then and this risky move cost me my job because after it I was kicked out. I am glad that I did it because if I hadn't had i would have felt awful.

- -Marlon, I would like to hear your opinion too. What did you think about Truman's situation?
- I am convinced, Truman was in a difficult situation. All of the actors had a hard job. I think it wasn't a bad thing, what Cristoph did. He gave Thruman an opportunity to grow up but when he grew up, I think Cristoph should have let him go. It really pissed me of when he sent the storm at him. I was so afraid, I though he would die!!! Fortunately he didn't, which was a miracle! I am happy he managed to leave the show and start his own life.
 - Were you true friend of Truman or you were just acting?
 - Well, sometimes I forgot that this is a movie and I spoke to him like a real friend. At these times I felt like he is my friend. I don't know what Thruman thinks about this friendship but I hope that we were true friends.

So if you think, you two were friends, then the other question is what does Meryl think? <u>-Have you ever felt ashamed about lying to Truman?</u>

- This was my job. I just did what I was told. I think every employee wants to impress their boss, so do I.

When Truman went crazy, I was really scared and wanted to quit from the job. Then I realized that this is my life. I almost know Meryl better than myself, if that's possible.

What made you happy?

-Through the years I became the most wanted actress in the world. I was requested to lots of shootings, but beside Truman show I hardly had time to do something else. That was my life! And to be honest, my salary was really great and that much money is worth giving up my life for. (Reklám...)

Have you loved Truman?

-As I said it was only my job. But Truman was the only man in my life. I'm a little bit sad, that I didn't have a real love story. As the years went by I felt responsible for Truman's life and started to have feelings for him, but I wouldn't say it was love. I just got used to this situation.

- -Back to Marlon, When you began this show, did you think that it will be this long?
- Well, yes,.... because Cristoph had a lot of ideas about this show. He knew, what Truman thinks. He knew what he would do. Of course he did, because it was him, who controlled the whole thing and manipulated everybody, especially Truman.
 - I think there is someone, who doesn't really share your view Marlon. Sylvia, could you tell us a little about how you met Truman?

Okay so I was hired to play a background extra in The Truman Show many years ago. I was given the role of Lauren, a fellow student at collage but I didnt have any important scenes . One day our eyes lokcked and I felt that there was something special about him. Unfortunatelly the producers had a set plan for all of his life which did not include him falling in love with me. They had another woman to play that role. We had some stolen moments together but the producers were against it. They forbid me to even talk to him and every time we were in the same place the dragged me away from him.

- -My last question is to Truman. What do you think, was it fair or unfair what they did to you?

 -I am really forgiving. I was just a child, whent they started the show with me. Maybe they just wanted to create me a better life.
